Background to the Behaviour Management Techniques we use in Paediatric Dentistry

Dr. Bernadette Drummond

We are often faced with caring for children who have not developed any skills in being a 'good dental patient'. Dental treatment requires levels of cooperation that allow us to examine teeth properly, take radiographs, provide local anaesthesia, use high speed handpieces, and use materials that smell and/or taste bad to a child. This presentation will look at what influences children's behaviour in the dental setting and the evidence we have for helping children develop coping skills to have good dental care.

Bernadette Drummond graduated from the University of Otago, did her graduate training at the Eastman Dental Center in Rochester NY and her PhD in Leeds. She is currently Associate Professor and Specialist in Paediatric Dentistry at the University of Otago and President of the Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons. She is responsible for the undergraduate and graduate programmes in paediatric dentistry and provides specialist dental care for children and adolescents with behavioural, developmental and medical problems. Her research interests are in dental prevention, outcomes of dental care and oral health related quality of life in children.

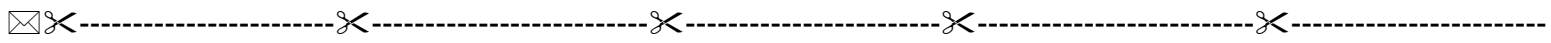
