## **“Management of Paediatric ENT Problems”**

### **Lecture Synopsis:**

Paediatric otorhinolaryngology is an important subspecialty in many parts of the world. Children are not small adults. Successful management requires clear understanding of the paediatric anatomy and the disease nature. In this lecture, common paediatric ENT problems will be discussed including obstructive sleep apnoea, tonsillitis, otitis media particularly in cleft children and sinusitis. With the advances in paediatric specialties and medical technology, we are now managing complex disorders in the tertiary centre such as difficult upper airway problems, congenital head and neck tumours, drooling, congenital ear abnormalities and profound hearing loss with cochlear implantation and bone anchored hearing aid (BAHA).

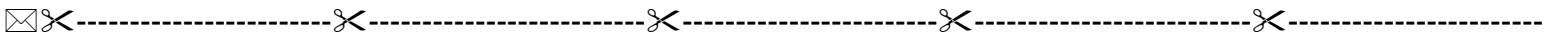
